This change is universal and unavoidable. Over-the-counter reading glasses may help temporarily, but they only treat the symptoms, not the root cause. Unlike glasses, contacts, or prescription eye drops, Refractive Lens Exchange corrects presbyopia at its source by removing the eye's aging natural lens and replacing it with a clear intraocular lens that can provide vision at multiple distances. In addition to correcting presbyopia, RLE can address other refractive errors such as nearsightedness, farsightedness, and astigmatism. The procedure also eliminates the risk of developing cataracts in the future, as the aging lens is permanently replaced with one that does not cloud over time.

For many patients, the benefits of RLE go beyond visual clarity. The procedure offers the freedom to live without dependency on glasses or contacts, a reduced need for future eye surgeries, and the convenience of a one-time solution that lasts for life. Because presbyopia is often accompanied by other vision issues, RLE is particularly advantageous for those seeking to simplify their vision correction needs in one safe, effective treatment.

Some patients may be candidates for LASIK with blended vision, a technique that corrects one eye for distance and the other for near tasks. However, this approach is not suitable for everyone, particularly those with more advanced lens aging or those who would prefer to avoid future cataract surgery. During an in-depth consultation, the Waite Vision team determines the most effective and safest option based on each patient's unique eye structure, vision history, and preferences.
