



Smart Technology and Energy Efficiency Drive Garage Door Replacement Market in British Columbia

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Homeowners increasingly prioritize energy efficiency and smart technology when replacing garage doors, reshaping the exterior renovation market across British Columbia.

Garage door replacement is emerging as a growing segment of the home improvement market as homeowners increasingly integrate smart technology and energy efficient building materials into their properties. Residential garage doors, historically treated as purely functional fixtures, are now being evaluated as design elements that contribute to curb appeal, home automation capabilities, and overall thermal performance.

A 2025 report from the Joint Center for Housing Studies at Harvard University projects continued growth in home improvement spending, with exterior replacements including doors and windows accounting for a significant share of the market. The trend is particularly pronounced in Greater Vancouver, where aging housing stock combined with rising property values has motivated owners to invest in upgrades that enhance both function and long term asset value. Canadian homeowners spent an estimated \$96 billion on renovations in 2025, according to Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation data, with exterior upgrades

representing a growing portion of that expenditure.

Smart technology integration is a key driver behind the replacement cycle. Modern garage door openers now feature Wi-Fi connectivity, allowing homeowners to monitor and operate their doors remotely through smartphone applications. Battery backup systems ensure operation continues during power outages, a feature that has become increasingly important in regions prone to extreme weather events. Belt drive openers have largely replaced chain drives in new installations due to their quieter operation, particularly in homes where garages are attached directly to living spaces.

"Homeowners are looking at garage doors differently than they did five years ago," said Jim McCormack, owner of JMac Garage Doors. "People want doors with better insulation, quieter openers, and connectivity to their home automation systems. What used to be a straightforward replacement is now part of a broader conversation about home efficiency and smart living. We are seeing more customers asking about R values and insulation performance than in previous years."

Energy efficiency is another factor accelerating the replacement cycle. Older wooden doors and single-layer steel doors lack the insulation values that modern homeowners expect, particularly in Vancouver's variable climate where temperature swings and moisture levels can affect home energy performance. Single-layer doors, which were standard in many homes built before 2000, provide minimal thermal resistance compared to modern insulated models. The resulting energy loss through an uninsulated garage door can affect heating and cooling costs for adjacent living spaces.

Industry professionals expect the trend toward upgraded garage door systems to continue as more homeowners become aware of the available technology and energy-saving options. The combination of smart technology adoption, improved materials, and growing awareness of home energy performance suggests the garage door replacement market will remain active through the remainder of 2026.
